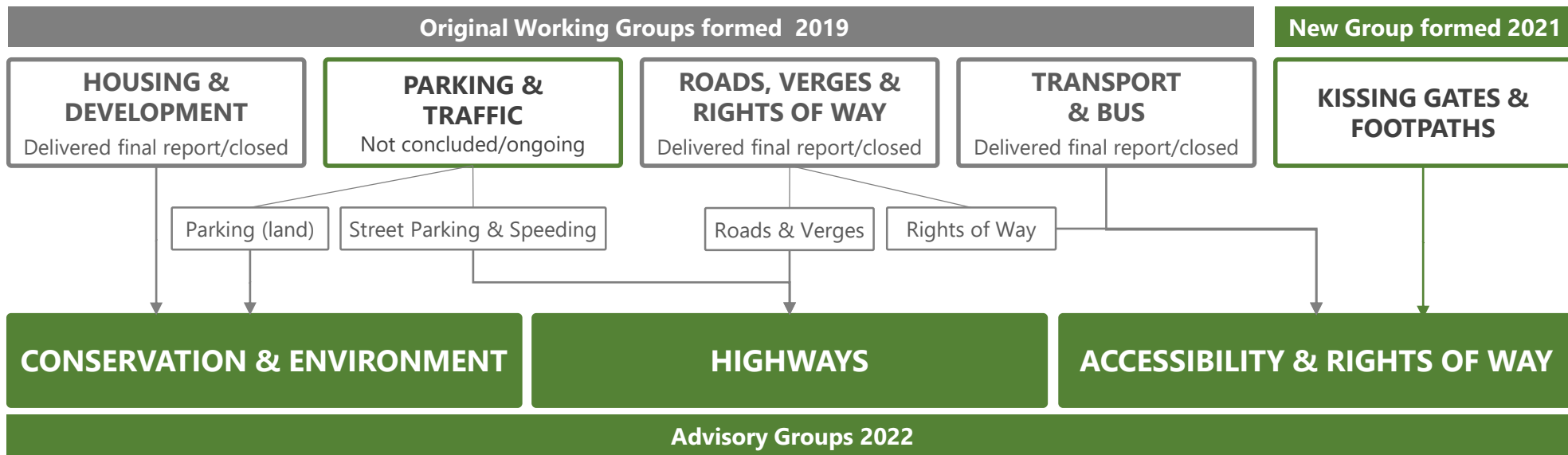


# TRANSITIONING THE GROUPS...



Review the recommendations of the Housing & Development Working Group and create an action plan:

1. Encourage wildlife conservation by planting trees, shrubs, wild flowers;
2. Consider creation of a Neighbourhood Plan, including funding options;
3. Consider options for land for parking, including the land off Pyatts Corner/Butts Lane;

Plus, working with village groups, consider / develop green initiatives in line with the Wiltshire Council Climate Plan.

Build on the work of the original Groups and consider measures/options for:

- Day-to-day street parking difficulties, especially Martins Road & Pyatts Corner, and school parking;
- Speeding controls, including speed limits, MetroCount, village gates;
- Review/monitor verge improvement measures including education to highlight parking and driver behaviour.

Work with villagers and landowners to improve accessibility on PROWs through local fields (primarily footpath KEEV1 btw lower Main Street - byway KEEV29 at end of Martins Lane).

Work with neighbouring PCs to maintain PROWs between parish boundaries.

Review recommendations of original Groups and:

- Consider accessibility issues around the village, including access to post boxes, footpaths to amenities, and other difficult paths/pavements for those with restricted walking ability, mobility scooters or wheelchairs;
- Periodically monitor our most-used footpaths and stiles to ensure they are well-maintained;
- Monitor transport issues and Help-a-Friend;
